PRIMHE will also recruit, select, and hire eight associate clinical social workers (ASW) annually (40 over the life of the project) for rural schools with demonstrated need. The project will provide clinical supervision, training, professional development, and support through a cohort Community of Practice.

In their first years, ASWs will work as interns and receive a \$20,000 living stipend while completing their clinical experience hours. Once hired at a participating rural district, assistance will be provided to the district to help pay the ASWs' salaries.
