

Essential Functions:

- < Develops/maintains instructional/interpretive displays for the purpose of educating visitors to the SCICON museum of natural history.
- < Feeds and cares for wildlife for the purpose of rehabilitation.
- < Handles wildlife for the purpose of demonstration or examination.
- < Instructs sixth grade students for the purpose of educating in outdoor education science concepts.
- < Instructs SCICON staff and volunteers for the purpose of teaching wildlife feeding and care skills.
- < Maintains records for the purpose of documenting museum items.
- < Maintains records of feeding, medication and inventory for the purpose of wildlife rehabilitation.

Skills, Knowledge and/or Abilities:
