

Skills, Knowledge and/or Abilities:

x Skills to:

- communicate effectively with students in outdoor/wilderness settings;
- communicate effectively with SCICON staff/classroom teachers/foresters and community members.

Knowledge of:

- forestry-related concepts.

Abilities to:

- speak, hear and understand spoken English;
- walk in mountainous terrain;
- speak clearly in loud audible levels.

Responsibilities include: working under direct supervision using standardized procedures; providing information and/or advising others; and operating within a defined budget. There is some opportunity to affect the Organization's services. The usual and customary methods of performing the job's functions requires the following physical demands: occasional lifting, carrying, pushing, and/or pulling; some stooping, kneeling, crouching, and/or crawling; and significant fine finger dexterity. Generally, the job requires 30% sitting, 35% walking and 35% standing. The job is performed under some temperature extremes.
