The job of Clinical Supervisor is the advanced journey level clinician who possesses full licensure with at least two years of post-licensure work experience. Incumbents are expected to provide qualifying supervision for Behavioral Health Services employees in addition to managing assignments requiring the highest level of clinical expertise. There is an increased level of administrative/management responsibilities along with the provision of team oversight.
