Job Summary:

The job of Behavior Consultant was established for the purpose of providing assistance and supervision to Behavior Tutors serving children with intensive behavioral intervention services using the principles of applied behavioral

- x Provides parent training to small groups on behavior management strategies for the purpose of assisting others to understand the steps necessary for the management of severe behaviors.
- x Participates/functions as a positive team member for the purpose of enhancing/sharing knowledge and skills for delivering best practices.
- x Participates in the development, implementation, and evaluation of behavior intervention plans in a variety of settings for the purpose of delivering effective programs to children with various mental health diagnoses, developmental disabilities, and severe behavior problems.
- x Provides behavioral consultation to family members and other members of the behavior intervention services team as they work with children with various mental health diagnoses, developmental disabilities, and severe behavior problems.
- x Receives referrals and background information for the purpose of assessing and implementing appropriate general behavior intervention services in various settings.
- x Assists support staff with the administration of intensive and general behavior intervention services.
- x Consults with the program coordinator for the purpose of completing appropriate assessments, documentation, and activities related to behavior intervention services.
